DESCRIPTION

Camp Pepin's target range is located in the backwoods and is where the Target Sports Director mainly operates. We currently offer archery, .22 rifles, and slingshots, and the Target Sports Director is responsible for the safety and enjoyment of all participants during these activities. During all Skill Classes and cabin activities, the Target Sports Director will provide safety guidelines and instruction on the use of the equipment, as well as a variety of games, activities, and challenges to ensure that each day is fun and exciting. We prefer applicants who possess certification in at least one area of target sports; however, applicable experience can be considered in certain situations.

The Target Sports Director is in charge of the general maintenance of all equipment and facilities, which includes cleaning, basic repair, and daily inspection/documentation. Target sports have the potential to be dangerous, so it is the responsibility of the Target Sports Director to be diligent in the supervision and instruction of both campers and staff on the proper use of equipment. Oftentimes camp is the first time campers will experience these activities, which are prime learning opportunities for personal goal-setting and self-improvement, perseverance and determination, friendly competition, and more. Through coaching and mentorship, the Target Sports Director can teach much more about life during archery class than simply how to shoot a bow and arrow.
